

## COVID response survey of CCIs

Carried out telephonic survey in the first week of May 2020 with 78 partner CCIs in Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Goa.



**78%**

CCIs have not sent children home



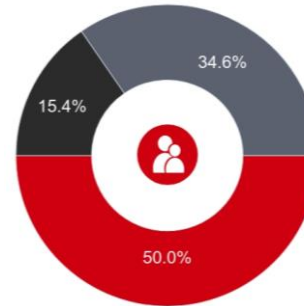
**82%**

CCIs have been approached by district authorities



**54%**

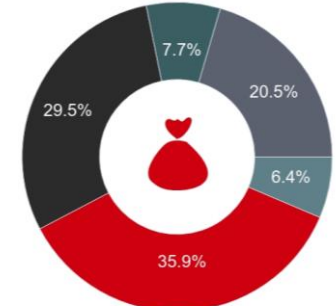
CCIs have not received any support in cash or kind from the Government



**50%**

CCIs are operating with fewer staff post lockdown

- 34.6% have staff staying in premises.  
- 15.4% are operating normally.



**72%**

CCIs have funds available for less than 6 months

- 6.4% - 0-1 month  
- 36% - upto 3 months  
- 29.5% - upto 6 months  
- 7.7% - upto 1 year  
- 20.5% - more than year

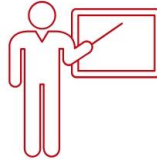

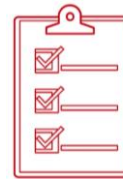


